What is Traka AccessCheck?

This highly affordable, one-stop-shop solution connects at-risk access points with our key cabinets or lockers preventing exit or entry unless the correct keys or assets have been collected or returned.

By connecting access control systems to cabinets or lockers and registering collection or return by sending a real-time notification to the access control system, we provide a fail-safe solution, enabling access or preventing departure only if correct keys or assets have been collected or returned. In doing so, it optimises daily operations by ensuring keys or assets are where they should be when needed, avoids the substantial upgrade or replacement costs of lost assets and prevents threats of assets going offsite, reducing the likelihood of key duplication or device cloning.

Additionally, it alleviates misconduct burdens on already-stretched staff by reducing manual processes and mitigates the significant reputational damage organisations face when an asset is exploited.



Mitigating risks with Traka AccessCheck

Operational and security risks

Losing assets or not having them accessible when needed, can create significant operational, security, reputational and cost risks to a variety of organisations.

Ensuring assets are available to authorised staff at the start of their shifts and/or returned for reuse at the end of their shifts, is laborious and often done manually, creating a variety of points of failure.

Not having assets available at the start of the shift delays the operation of an organisation with significant impact on staff who are already stretched with existing duties.



Off-site asset misuse challenges

Taking keys offsite creates the danger of loss or duplication, meaning that, high-security organisations will need to replace locks and keys, requiring significant, unbudgeted expenditure. This burden also results in unplanned effort, lost time, leaving them exposed to potential "threats".



Assets such as laptops or tablets being taken offsite, not only creates the risk and replacement costs of loss but also exploits organisations to cloning or hacking threats, again burdening them with significant, unplanned expenditure, additional effort and loss of time to mitigate the threats, leaving them vulnerable in the interim.

Security and financial consequences

Managing the collection and return of assets, when done sub-optimally, also creates security burdens, potentially leading to interruptions or failure to complete other vital duties as well exposure to "lost-cost" responsibilities or worse still, risks of gross misconduct.

For organisations that are budget-restricted or have a small access control "estate" as well as the above challenges, funding the costs of a fully blown access control system is unviable and leaves them exposed to all the above risks.
